








Arizonans' Views on Elected Officials (Muncipal Statistical Area) (Gallup/CFA 2020 Survey)





## Views on Select Electoral Reforms






Arizonans' Views on Electoral Reforms (Generation) (Gallup/CFA 2020 Survey. All respondents were over 18 years of age)




Favor offering early in-person voting over multiple weeks leading up to election day

Favor moving to ranked choice voting in state elections where voters rank candidates in order of preference regardless of their political party

Favor sending all registered voters a ballot by mail, while maintaining in-person voting options

Favor offering same day voter registration (register and vote on election day)

Favor offering automatic voter registration when applying for a state ID/driver's license
